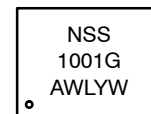

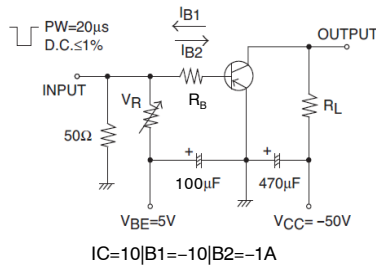


Figure 1. Switching Time Test Circuit

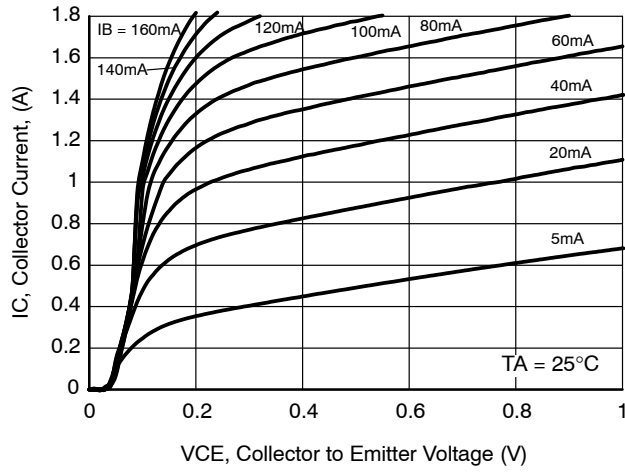


Figure 2. IC – VCE

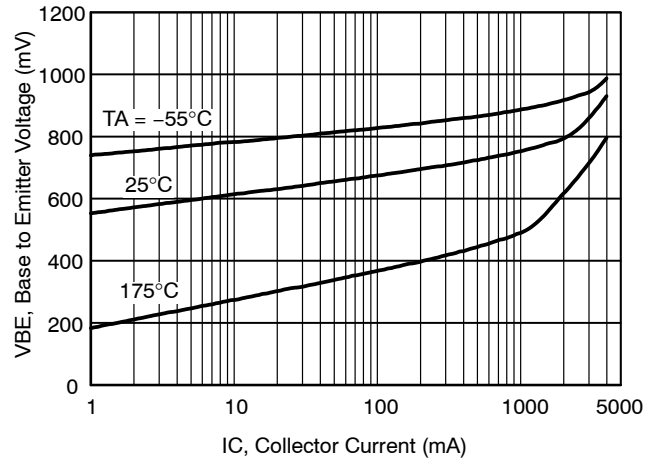


Figure 3. VBE – IC

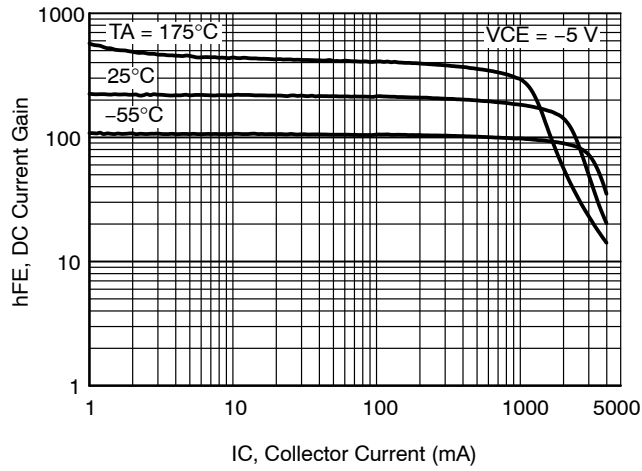


Figure 4. hFE – IC

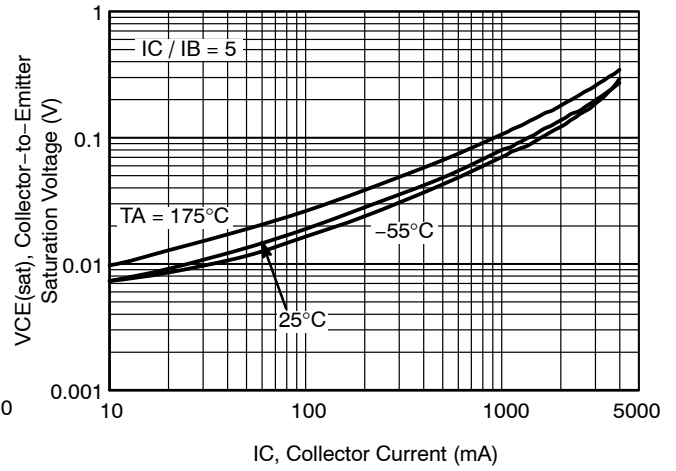


Figure 5. VCE(sat) – IC

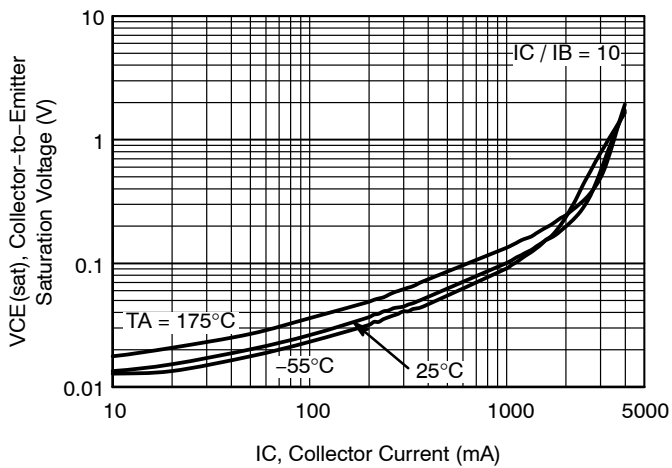


Figure 6. VCE(sat) – IC

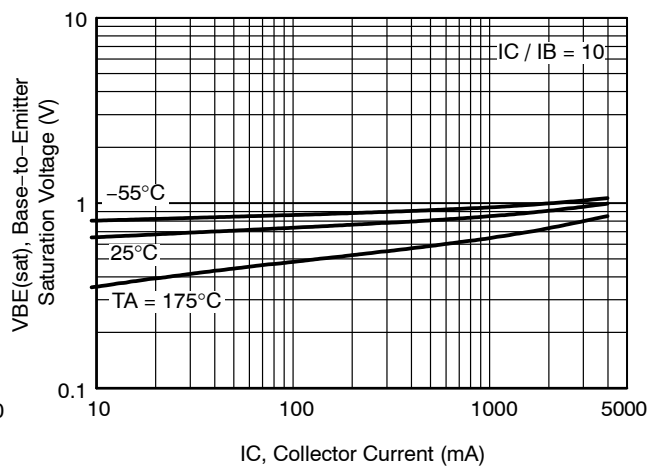


Figure 7. VBE(sat) – IC

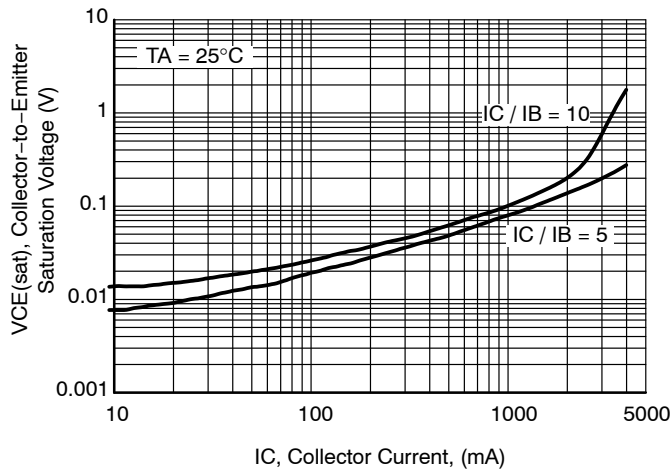


Figure 8. $V_{CE(sat)}$ – I_C

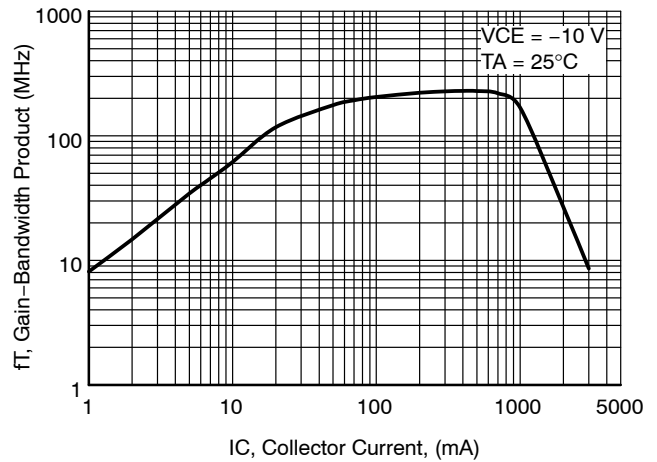


Figure 9. f_T – I_C

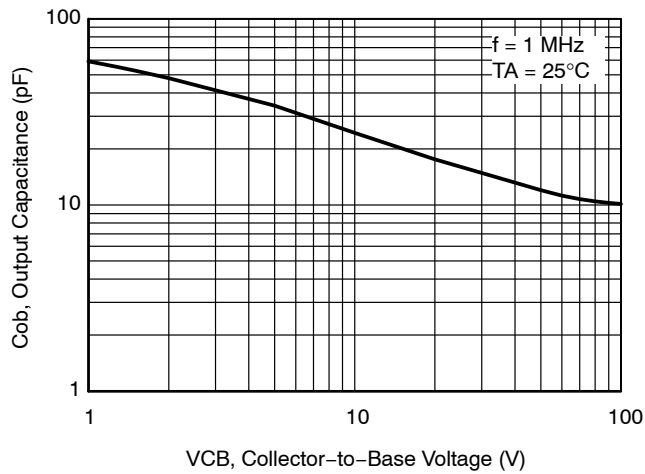


Figure 10. C_{ob} – V_{CB}

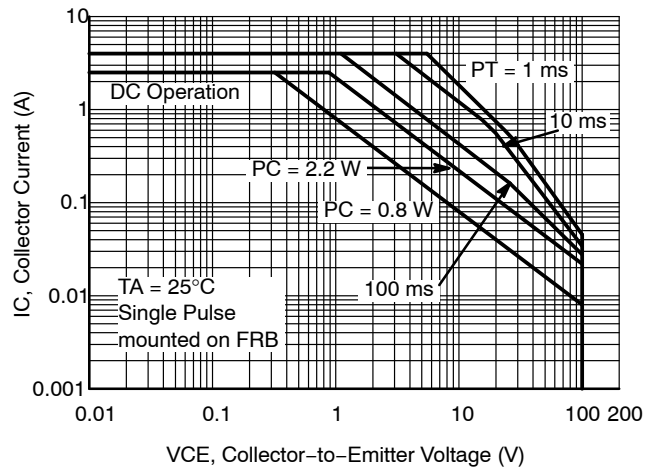


Figure 11. Safe Operating Area

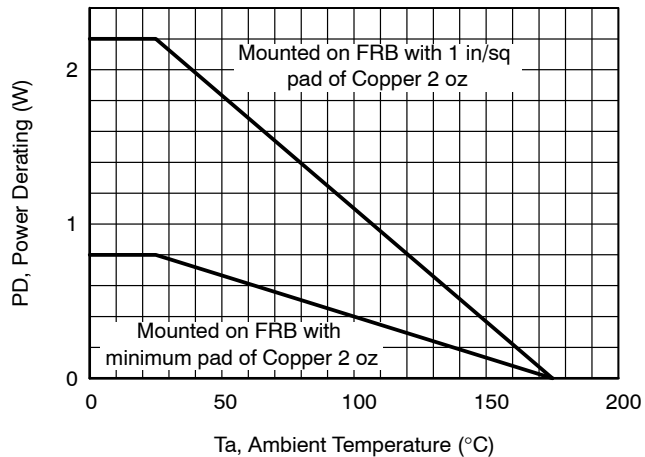


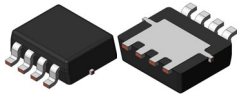
Figure 12. Power Derating
