1.1 IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS AND WARNINGS

Prior to installation and use of this product, the following WARNINGS should be observed.

- Installation and servicing should only be done by Qualified Service and Installation Personnel.
- 2. Installation shall be done in accordance with all local and national electrical and mechanical codes utilizing only approved materials.
- Use only installation methods and materials capable of supporting four (4) times the maximum specified load.
- 4. Use stainless steel hardware to fasten the mount to outdoor surfaces.
- To prevent damage from water leakage when installing a mount outdoors on a roof or wall, apply sealant around the bolt holes between the mount and mounting surface.

1.2 UNPACKING INSTRUCTIONS

Unpack and inspect all parts carefully.

The following parts are supplied:

- 1 Wall mount
- 2 1/4-20 x 1/2" screws
- 1 Installation/Operation Manual (C261M)

Be sure to save the shipping carton and any inserts. They are the safest material in which to make future shipments.

If an item appears to have been damaged in shipment, replace it properly in its carton and contact the factory at 1-800-289-9100 or 1-209-292-1981 for a replacement. (International customers fax 1-209-348-1120 for authorization and instructions.)

If an item needs to be returned to the factory for repair, consult the WARRANTY AND RETURN section of this manual for instructions.

1.3 RECOMMENDED TOOLS

Pelco does not supply basic tools needed for the installation process. The following tools are recommended:

Drill

Hand tools

2.0 DESCRIPTION

The EM1450 Light Duty Wall Mount has been designed for use with the EH2508, EH2512, EH2515, EH3508, EH3512, and EH3515 enclosures. It can be installed on any wall or vertical surface and is capable of supporting up to 20 lbs (9 kg).

The EM1450 has an adjustable tilt table that allows mechanical positioning of the enclosure.

3.0 INSTALLATION



CAUTION: Make sure that the installation method and fasteners can support four times the weight of the mount, enclosure, and camera.




Figure 1. EM1450 Mounting Template

- Drill holes in the mounting surface using the mount as a template, or use the template provided in Figure 1.
- Attach the mount to a solid surface with three 1/4" diameter fasteners (not supplied), or where there are wall studs, use one 5/16" fastener and one 1/4" fastener.

If you install the mount outdoors, rain water could leak through the holes for the mounting bolts and damage the wall.

To prevent water damage, seal the bolt holes with an appropriate sealant. Apply the sealant around the bolt holes between the mount and the mounting surface.

- Attach the enclosure to the tilt table with the two 1/4-20 screws that are provided.
- Loosen the bolt on the tilt table support bracket and adjust the tilt table to the desired direction. Tighten the bolt. Loosen the two screws on the tilt table and adjust it for the desired angle. Tighten the screws.




Figure 2. EM1450 Dimension Drawing

5.0 WARRANTY AND RETURN INFORMATION

WARRANTY

Pelco will repair or replace, without charge, any merchandise proved defective in material or workmanship for a period of one (1) year after the date of shipment. Exceptions to this warranty are as noted below:

- Two (2) years on all standard motorized and fixed focal length lenses.
- Two (2) years on Legacy[®], Intercept[®], CM8500/CM9500/CM9750 Matrix, Spectra[™], DF5 Series and DF8 Fixed Dome products.
- Two (2) years on WW5700 series window wiper (excluding wiper blades).
- Two (2) years on cameras.
- Six (6) months on all pan and tilts, scanners or preset lenses used in continuous motion applications (e.g., preset scan, tour and auto scan modes).

Pelco will warranty all replacement parts and repairs for 90 days from the date of Pelco shipment. All goods requiring warranty repair shall be sent freight prepaid to Pelco, Clovis, California. Repairs made necessary by reason of misuse, alteration, normal wear, or accident are not covered under this warranty.

Pelco assumes no risk and shall be subject to no liability for damages or loss resulting from the specific use or application made of the Products. Pelco's liability for any claim, whether based on breach of contract, negligence, infringement of any rights of any party or product liability, relating to the Products shall not exceed the price paid by the Dealer to Pelco for such Products. In no event will Pelco be liable for any special, incidental or consequential damages (including loss of use, loss of profit and claims of third parties) however caused, whether by the negligence of Pelco or otherwise.

The above warranty provides the Dealer with specific legal rights. The Dealer may also have additional rights, which are subject to variation from state to state.

If a warranty repair is required, the Dealer must contact Pelco at (800) 289-9100 or (209) 292-1981 to obtain a Repair Authorization number (RA), and provide the following information:

- 1. Model and serial number
- 2. Date of shipment, P.O. number, Sales Order number, or Pelco invoice number
- 3. Details of the defect or problem

If there is a dispute regarding the warranty of a product which does not fall under the warranty conditions stated above, please include a written explanation with the product when returned.

RETURNS

In order to expedite parts returned to the factory for repair or credit, please call the factory at (800) 289-9100 or (209) 292-1981 to obtain an authorization number (CA number if returned for credit, and RA number if returned for repair). Goods returned for repair or credit should be clearly identified with the assigned CA/RA number and freight should be prepaid. All merchandise returned for credit may be subject to a 20% restocking and refurbishing charge.
