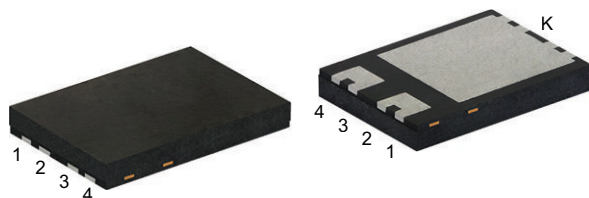
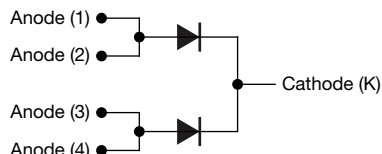

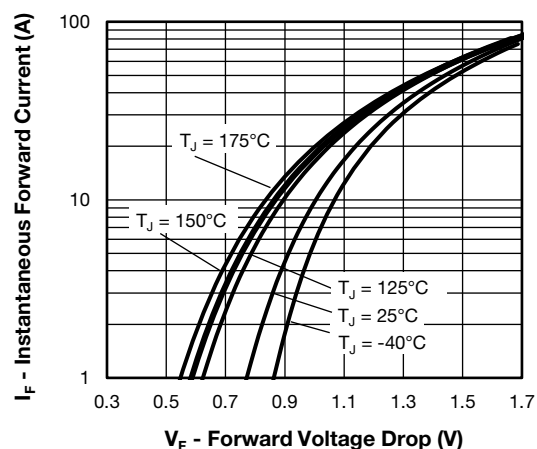


Fig. 1 - Typical Forward Voltage Drop Characteristics, per Leg

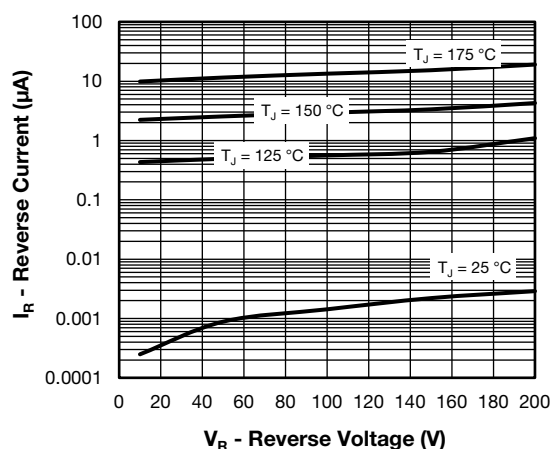


Fig. 2 - Typical Values of Reverse Current vs. Reverse Voltage, per Leg

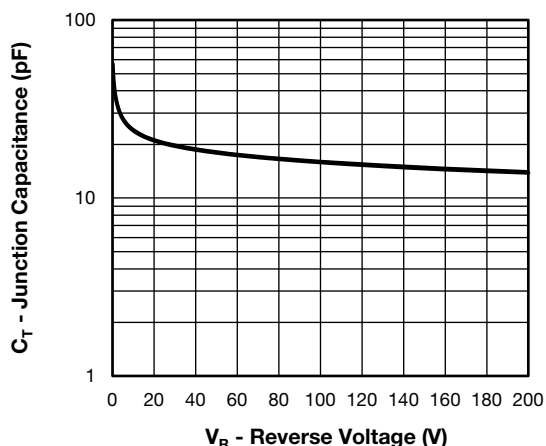


Fig. 3 - Typical Junction Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage, per Leg

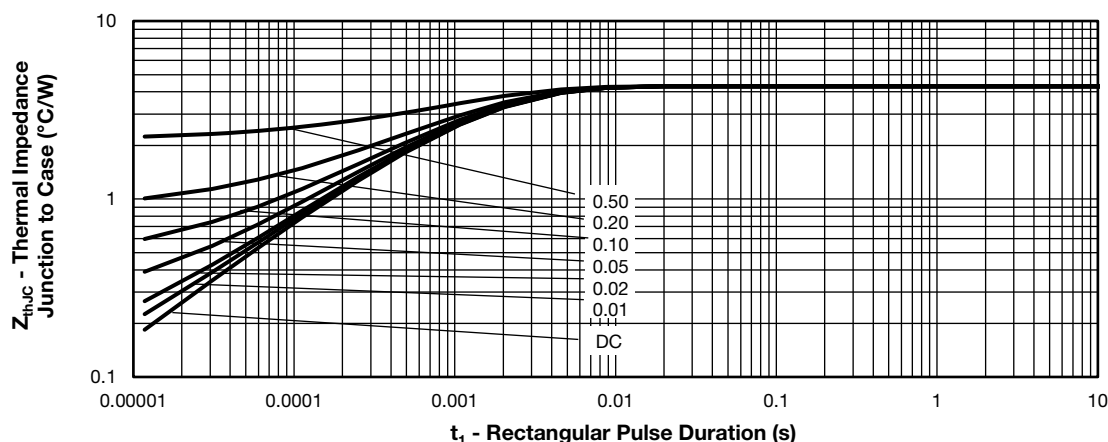


Fig. 4 - Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction to Mount, per Leg

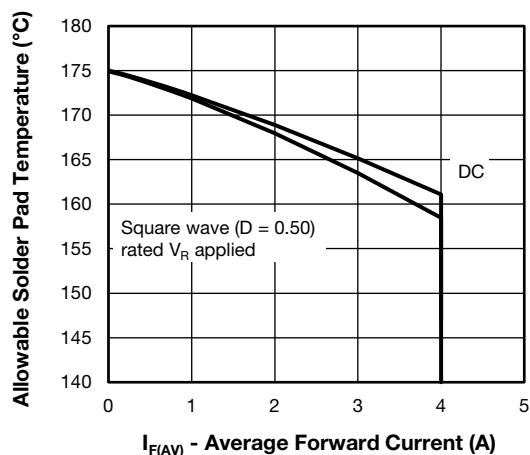


Fig. 5 - Maximum Allowable Mount Temperature vs. Average Forward Current, per Leg

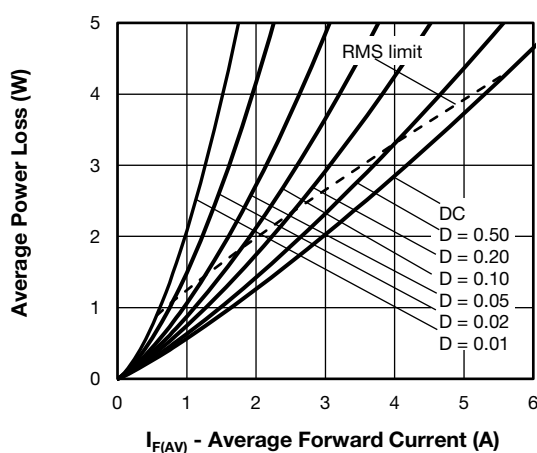


Fig. 6 - Forward Power Loss Characteristics, per Leg

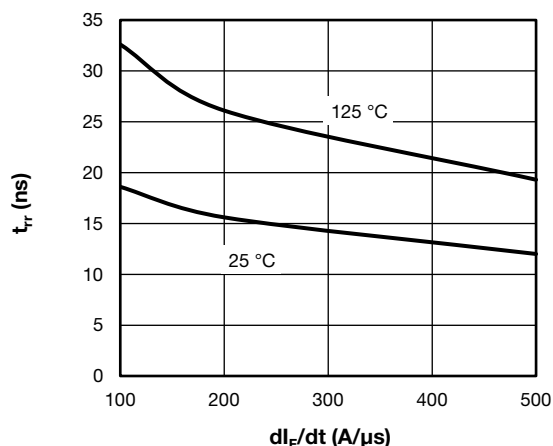
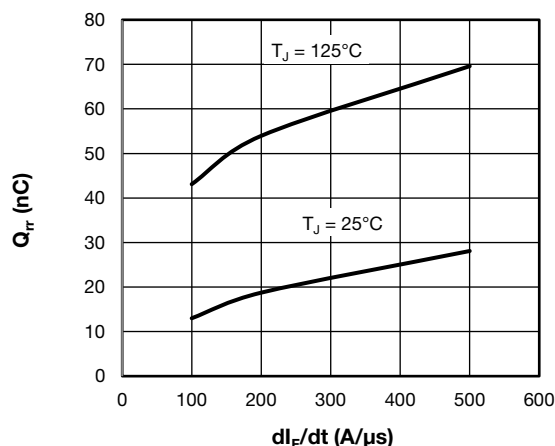
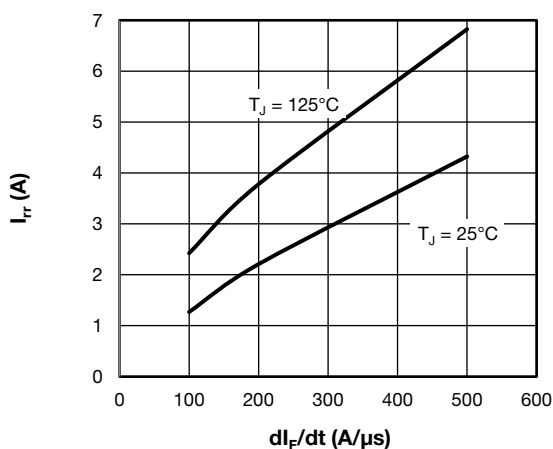
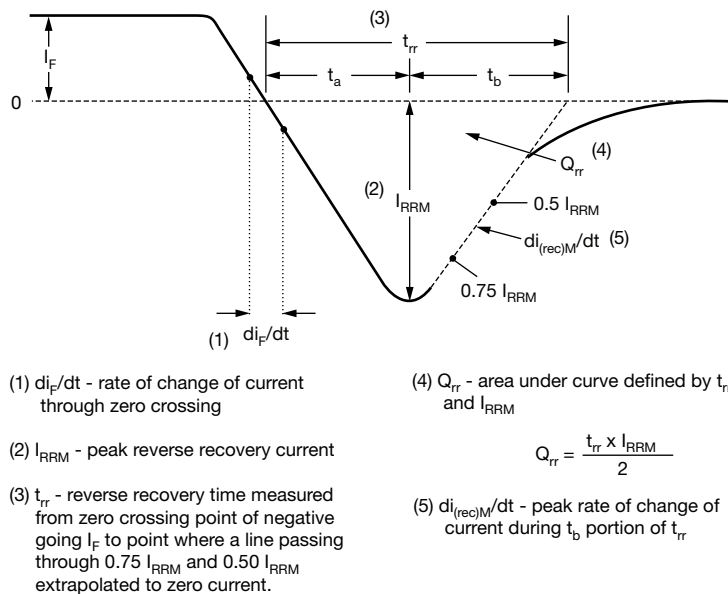

Fig. 7 - Typical Reverse Recovery Time vs. di_F/dt , per Leg
