HEAVY-DUTY INDUSTRIAL BROWGUARD & POLYCARBONATE VISOR WITH RATCHET ADJUSTABLE HEAD HARNESS & INTEGRAL CHINGUARD

EYE & FACE PROTECTION

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Before use, the browguard should be fitted to the visor
In use, ensure that the Faceshield fits comfortably and securely on the head
Ensure that the visor is in place before entering the hazard area

MATERIALS

Browguard: Polypropylene
Head Harness: Nylon
Visor: 1mm Polycarbonate

FACESHIELD FEATURES & PERFORMANCE

Offers protection against medium energy high speed particles at 120m/s (270mph), liquid droplets and molten metal
The optical qualities of the visor comply with the requirements of optical class 1 (highest)
Heavy-duty industrial browguard and visor with ratchet adjustable head harness and integral chinguard
Offers all round protection to the face area and to the sides including the temple area

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

The browguard may be cleaned with soap and warm water and dried with a soft cloth
Do not clean with chemical or abrasive cleaners
The eye shield should be stored out of direct sunlight, away from chemicals and not exposed to extremes of temperature

The Polycarbonate Visor Avenger Deluxe conforms to EN 166.1.B.3.9

LIMITATIONS OF USE

Protection will only be offered if the faceshield is fitted correctly
If the faceshield becomes scratched or damaged they should be replaced
Do not apply paint, solvents, adhesives or self-adhesive labels, except in accordance with instructions from the manufacturer
The harness, when in contact with the skin may cause allergic reactions to susceptible individuals. If this occurs leave the hazard area, remove the faceshield and seek medical advice
