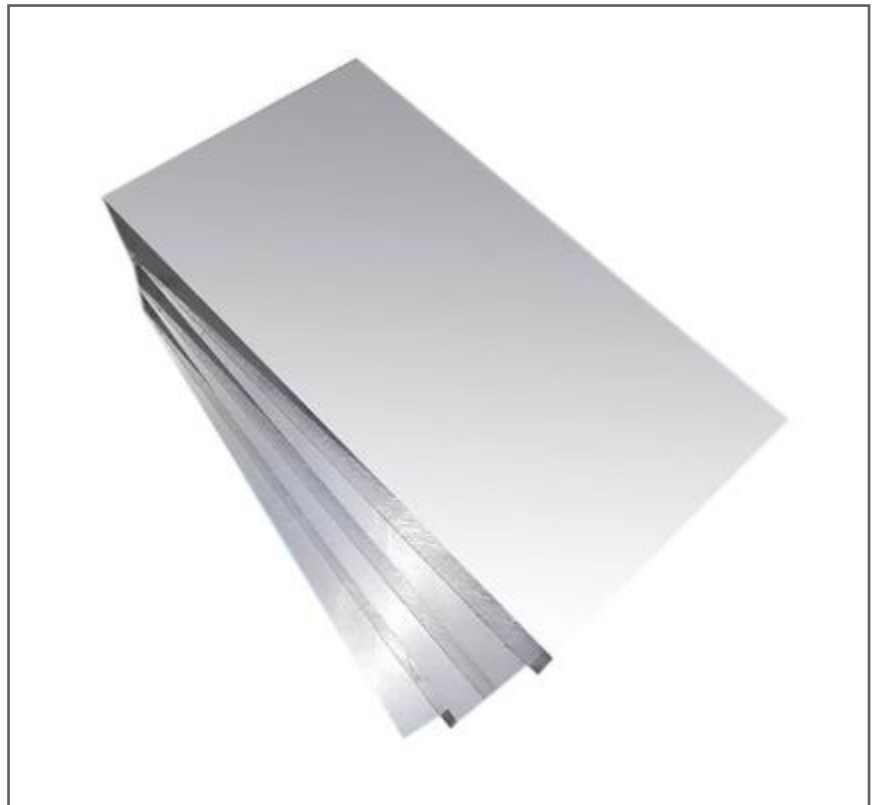

- *Low-Temperature Performance: Maintains its strength and toughness even at cryogenic temperatures (below -50°C), unlike many steels that become brittle in the cold.*
- *Dimensional Stability: Exhibits minimal warping after heat treatment, which is essential for precision molds and high-tolerance mechanical parts.*
- *Responds well to hardcoat (Type III) anodizing, which can be used to significantly improve its surface protection and wear resistance.*

Applications:

- *Airframes and Structures: Used for wing spars, ribs, and fuselage frames that must carry enormous loads.*
- *Skin Panels: T6 temper sheets are standard for aircraft skins.*
- *Landing Gear: Chosen for its ability to withstand sudden impacts during take-off and landing.*
- *Spacecraft: Components like heat shields and structural parts use 7075 because it manages heat well and resists wear.*
