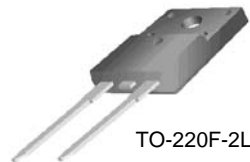

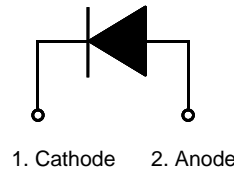

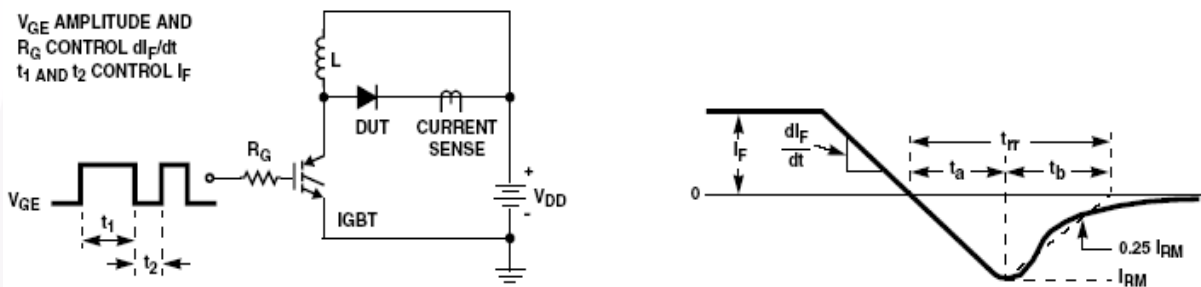


Figure 1. Diode Reverse Recovery Test Circuit & Waveform

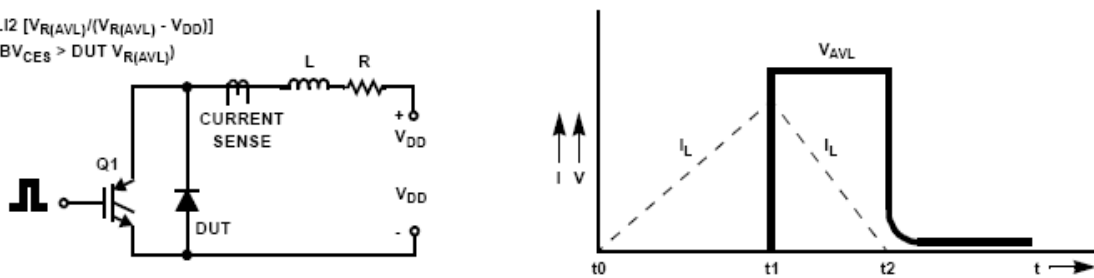


Figure 2. Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveform

Figure 3. Typical Forward Voltage Drop vs. Forward Current

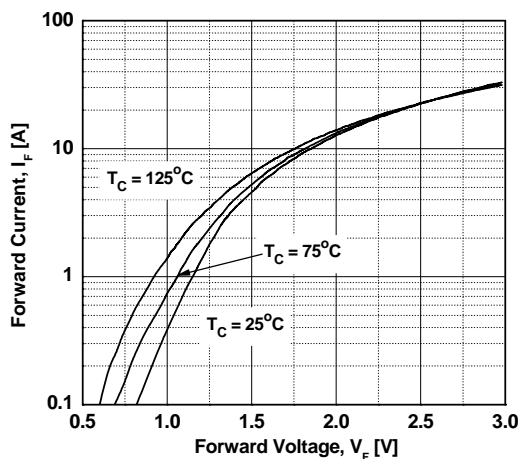


Figure 4. Typical Reverse Current vs. Reverse Voltage

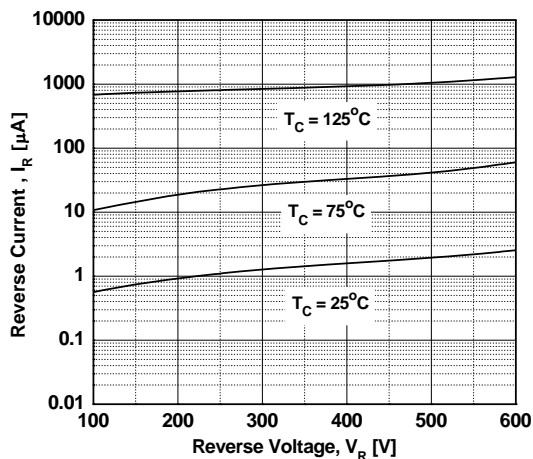


Figure 5. Typical Junction Capacitance

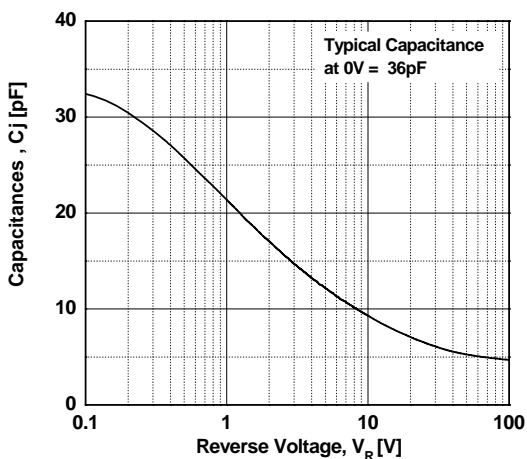


Figure 6. Typical Reverse Recovery Time vs. di_F/dt

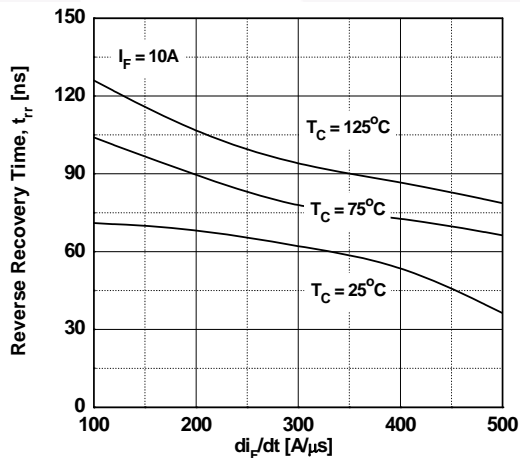


Figure 7. Typical Reverse Recovery Current vs. di_F/dt

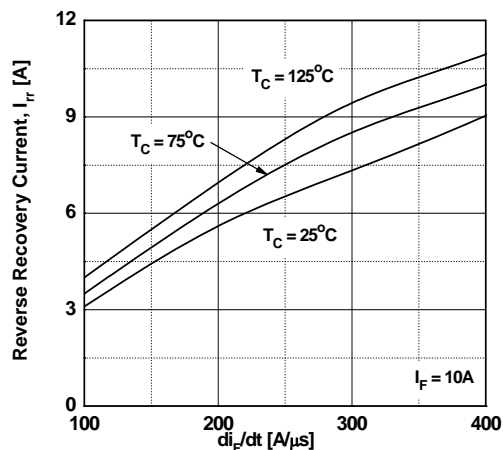
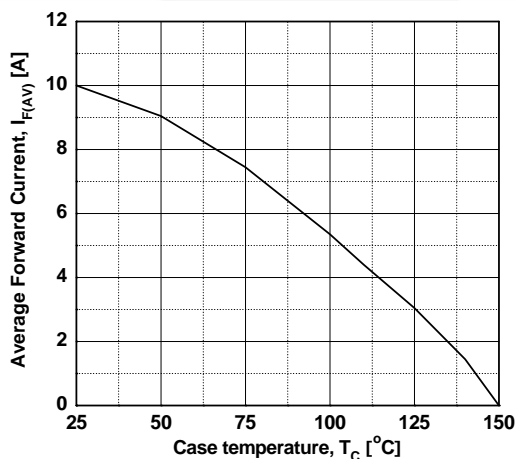


Figure 8. Forward Current Derating Curve

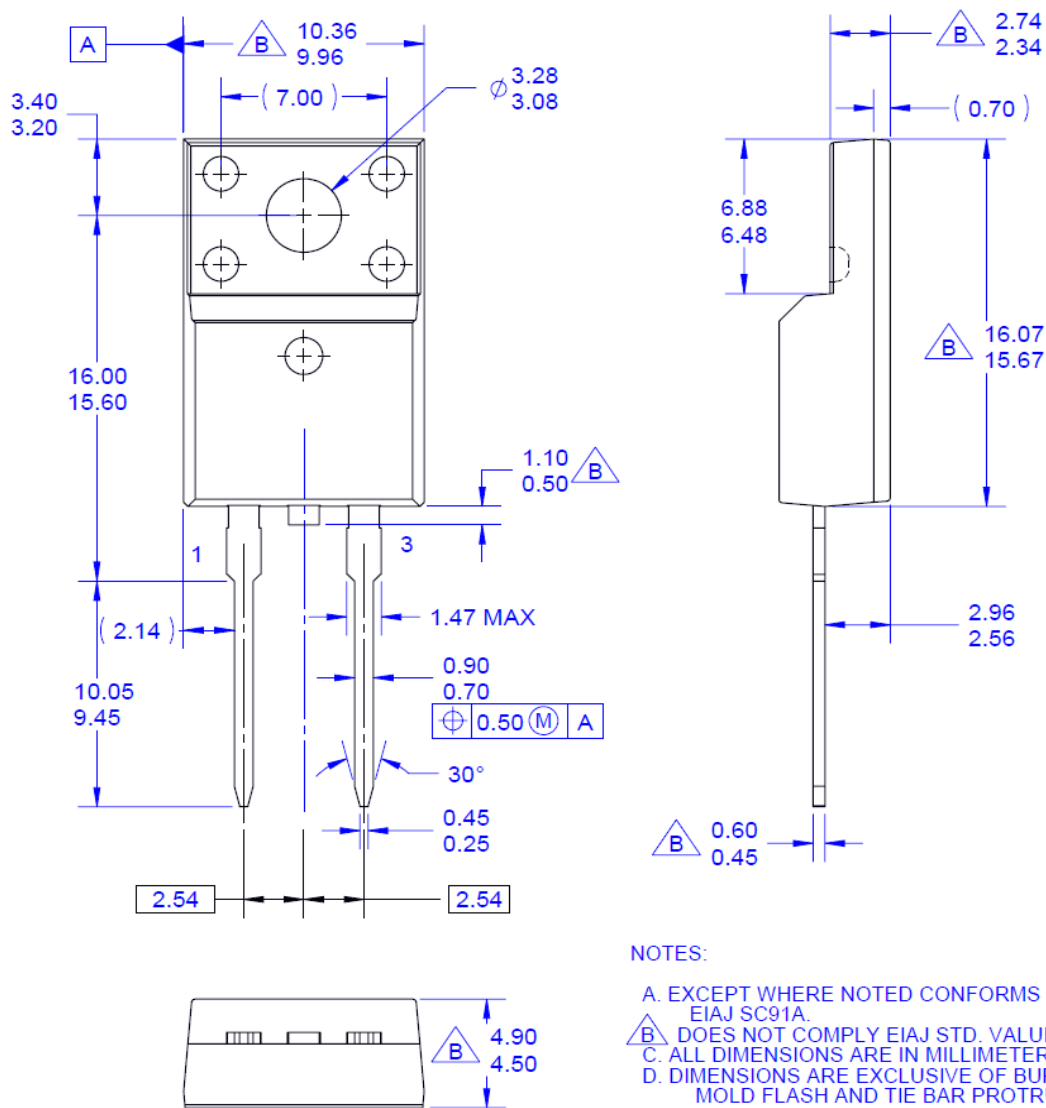


Figure 9. TO-220F 2L - 2LD; TO220; MOLDED; FULL PACK
