


MEASURING GUIDE

Measurements must be taken wearing clothing usually worn underneath waterproof outerwear. The tape measure should be fairly loose and not pulled too tight.

- ✓ **BUST** - measure under the arms at the fullest part around the bust horizontally with arms by your side
- ✓ **WAIST** - measure around the natural waistline at the fullest part
- ✓ **HIP** - with the feet together measure around the fullest part of the hips
- ✓ **HEIGHT** - with bare feet together measure from the top of the head to the floor
- ✓ **INSIDE LEG** - in bare feet take the measurement from the top of the inside leg and measure down the inside leg to the floor


Once measurements are taken compare them to the fit guide measurement tables to find your Jacket and Trouser size.

When fitting the Trouser if the waist and seat measurements fall into different size categories then choose the larger size to ensure the trouser is not too close fitting.

If the height and inside leg measurements fall into different length categories then choose the jacket length based on the height measurement and the trouser length based on the inside leg measurement.

**These styles are historically perceived as FEMALE but can be worn by any person who's body measurements fit into the above tables.*

- ✓ **WAIST** - measure around the natural waistline at the fullest part
- ✓ **SEAT** - with the feet together measure around the fullest part of the hips
- ✓ **HEIGHT** - with bare feet together measure from the top of the head to the floor
- ✓ **INSIDE LEG** - in bare feet take the measurement from the top of the inside leg and measure down the inside leg to the floor

Once measurements are taken compare them to the fit guide measurement tables to find your Jacket and Trouser size.

When fitting the Trouser if the waist and seat measurements fall into different size categories then choose the larger size to ensure the trouser is not too close fitting.
